

Information, Communication, Technology (ICT) Portfolio Assessment

What is an ePortfolio? An ePortfolio is a collection of artifacts assembled by students in grades 6-8 that demonstrates mastery of the following technology standards. We ask students to assemble these artifacts in the form of a Microsoft PowerPoint presentation that is presented to the teachers at the end of the year. Students should collect artifacts throughout the year and save their information for the final presentation. Grade 8 students who show mastery of the following standards are promoted to advanced computer classes at the high school. If students do not show mastery of each standard, they will be asked to continue to work on this assessment over the summer before they enter high school.

Content NETS-S1, NETS-S3	ePortfolio incorporates all artifacts required by content area teachers.	
Reflections Ed 306.42	A written reflection is included which describes the student's goals for continued learning (long and short term).	

The ePortfolio is a pass/fail assessment. To pass the ePortfolio, students must achieve mastery in all standard areas.
